

**Uterine Fibroids** are benign (non-cancerous) growths in the uterus. They are the most common type of growth found in a woman's pelvis, occurring in as many as 80% of women. In some women, fibroids remain small and do not cause any symptoms or problems. However, in some women fibroids can cause problems because of their size, number and location.

**Symptoms:**

Changes in menstruation, pain, pressure, enlarged uterus and abdomen, miscarriages, infertility.
